

Dear Friends in Christ,

In paragraph 14 of *Sacrosanctum Concilium* the council Fathers wrote "The Church earnestly desires that all the faithful be led to that full, conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations called for by the very nature of the liturgy. Such participation be the Christian people as 'chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people' is their **right** and **duty** by reason of their baptism." I added my own emphasis there that we are called to participate fully in the Mass when present.

The General Instruction on the Roman Missal, promulgated on Nov 27, 2011 goes further stating that we should

- ...avoid any appearance of singularity or division
- ...form one body, whether in hearing the Word of God, or in taking part in the prayers and in the singing...
- The faithful, moreover, should not refuse to serve the People of God in gladness whenever they are asked to perform some particular service or function in the celebration.

If you are a Liturgical Minister, please do not forget to sign up for next Sunday's Liturgy Conference. If you are not currently a liturgical minister, please prayerfully consider if your blessings are calling you to serve.




