Next weekend St. Vincent de Paul and Nativity of the Lord will hold their annual Mission Co-Op. Pat Maloney, of Franciscan Mission Service will speak at both parishes, right before Mass at one, right after communion at the other, switching places on Sunday. Envelopes are in little blue baskets at the church entry ways this weekend. Here is a brief summary of their work.

Franciscan Mission Service (FMS) is a Catholic, 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, FMS prepares and sends lay people to serve communities in South America, the Caribbean, and here in the United States—and the organization relies on the prayers and financial support of U.S. parishes to do this. In anticipation of this visit, Franciscan Mission Service invites parishioners to reflect on Pope Leo XIV's words from his first papal message: "Together, we must look for ways to be a missionary Church, a Church that builds bridges and encourages dialogue, a Church ever open to welcoming... all those who are in need of our charity, our presence, our readiness to dialogue and our love." 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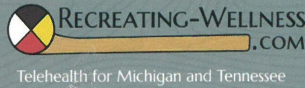
